"Brilliant!" (NME about WhoMadeWho)

After the album debuts of HEADMAN (2001), MOCKY (2002), KAMERAKINO (2003, the first band of FRANZ FERDINAND guitar player Nick McCarthy) und MUNK (2004) the German GOMMA label comes up with a new band:

WhoMadeWho. Three guys from Denmark that have a very own, fresh sound. A band that causes big reactions already with DJ's, clubs and press.

WMW are a trio that plays DISCO. But not mixing it with (Post)Punk and New Wave, like so many other bands right now. WhoMadeWho use some slightly different influences: from Surf to Folk, from 70ies Funk to Pop. A very charming songwriting mixed with a huge dose of Italo Disco, without being cheesy. So WMW is definitely not one of the "THE" bands and also not your common Electro Punk project. These guys have a very personal, unique style.

The band released three singles since 2004 which caused some good buzz and some heavy rotations with DJ's all over the place. Especially "Satisfaction" was a hit in many clubs. Fast people realized that WhoMadeWho is a fascinating band and currently you can see the band playing their live shows in the clubs all over Europe. The band already was asked to play many of the "hot" clubs and parties. TRASH/ London, OPTIMO/ Glasgow, KILL THE DJ in Paris, WEEKEND in Berlin and CULTURE CLUB in Ghent wanted them. VICE Magazine and Berlin's LOWDOWN invited WMW to enrich their lounge shindigs. The last festival summer found a good aggrandizement with the WhoMadeWho gig at SONAR.

Tomas Hoffding is well known for playing in Denmark's local Garage rock scene. He plays the bass and sings in WhoMadeWho. Tomas Barfod - the drummer - is also known as an excellent House DJ in the new Scandinavian Club scene. (That's why you can feel the house influence in WMW songs). And Jeppe Kjellberg, the guitar player and singer, used to play a lot in avant-garde jazz projects. He lived in New York no long ago, where he played with local bands (and recorded a solo album "Go Out" with former Lounge Lizards guitar player David Tronzo).
